

Classroom Rules

- ❖ **Be On Time.** You are expected to be in your seat working on the opening activity when the bell rings. You are officially TARDY if you are not inside the class when the bell rings. Please see me if you have any reason for being TARDY. Always wear your IDENTIFICATION badge.

- ❖ **Be Prepared.** Have proper materials to include pencils and notebook. You are expected to have needed supplies and assignments every day. Class time may not be taken up borrowing supplies from others. Be ready when the bell rings.
- ❖ **Turn In All Assignments.** Follow my directions. Be responsible to get make-up work when you are absent.
- ❖ **Get Permission** from me before leaving the class. Students must have a pass to leave. Do not ask to leave the first and the last **10** minutes of the class. Stay in your seat until I release you to end the class.
